The Manchester Unity Building is not merely a location - it is a character in the Smile Solutions story. Built during the Great Depression, it represents the same values that define the practice: vision, courage, craftsmanship, and the belief that beauty and function are inseparable.

### ### The Restoration

Kia's mother cried when she first saw the building's dilapidated interior: "My son has made a big mistake." Over 12+ years, Smile Solutions reversed decades of neglect:

- **Level 1:** 12 heritage shopfronts restored as dental suites. Italian marble sourced from the only quarry with the correct plum colour. Copper leaf signage created by an artisan from southern NSW (the previous artisan had died in 2008). All metalwork is solid bronze or solid copper - never vinyl.
- **Level 12 (Rooftop):** Former tropical restaurant converted to specialist centre housing orthodontists, root canal specialists, and oral surgeons.
- **The Tower:** 24 metres high above the building (total height 64m), originally built as a "beacon of hope" during the Depression - a "sleight of hand" past council height limits. Now houses the orthodontic centre with five panoramic chairs.
- **Level 11:** The most challenging restoration - 15 months. 1990s developers had turned the boardroom and grand secretary's offices into white-box apartments, removing or painting over timber panelling. Smile Solutions reversed this completely. The original 5.9m Queensland Maple boardroom table (320kg glass top, imported from UK or France) has never left the room. Rooms are relabelled with 1932 terminology in copper leaf: "Inspector" (IT department), "Typing Room" (printers), "Tearoom" (kitchen).

### ### Philosophy

Kia sees innovation as "an obligation on our free thinkers and our entrepreneurs - not a choice." He built Smile Solutions on a principle that has never changed: absorb the complexity so the patient experiences simplicity.

His origin story is the stuff of legend in Australian dentistry. After three years of dreaming that his practice should be in "a church," he walked down Swanston Street, looked up at the Manchester Unity Building, and said: "Oh my god, that is my church." He purchased Level 1 within a week. Ten years later, he had five floors.

"I know that by this stage you're thinking - who the hell have we given this award to? This guy's an absolute nut case!" - Kia, Telstra Awards speech

### ### Leadership Style

Kia is a hands-on founder who has never stepped back from the clinical or strategic frontline. He personally conducts second-round recruitment interviews, reviews daily banking reports from every practice, writes open letters to industry regulators, mentors 200+ dental practice principals locally and internationally, and maintains active involvement in heritage restoration, property management, and community philanthropy.

He frames the practice as a living entity: "As a parent, I was just there to guide her growth. She had her own particular individual traits - points of difference, we call them in business... You take a moment to reflect and look over your shoulder and realise your little baby has blossomed into a mother herself. She is now nurturing so many within her." (Telstra acceptance speech, 2014)
